It will address all of those issues and more. It will be taught by people with years of experience in writing and reviewing grant applications on organ donation and on other public health issues.</i></p> <p><i>Writing a grant application that hits the mark is both an art and a science. It's not simple, but it's certainly doable. The good news is that good grant application writers are not born that way. They are the product of experience and practice, of successful and not-so-successful experiences in the grant world. If you want to learn the process of preparing competitive grant applications, if you want to learn from someone else's experience and if you want to gain some knowledge with hands on practice opportunities, this workshop is for you.</i></p> <p><i>While DoT/HRSA grant programs will primarily be addressed, the information presented will help you develop proposals for other funding agencies and foundations in the government as well as private sector.</i></p>
